

# Rural VFD Assistance Program (HB 2604)

## **Grants: Training Tuition, Dorm Lodging, Meal Cards TEEX 86<sup>th</sup> Annual Municipal Fire School (July 19 – 24, 2015)**

#### Who is eligible...

- Chartered, non-profit volunteer fire departments operated by its members are eligible.
- Part-paid/part-volunteer fire departments are eligible provided the number of paid members is 20 or less.

#### **Reimbursement Rates...**

- Training tuition grants are available at 100% of the actual cost of tuition up to a maximum of \$610 per trainee. The maximum grant assistance per school per department is \$6,100.
- Grants for Dorm Lodging are available at \$37 per day up to a maximum of \$185 per person (5 days).
- Meal Card grants are available up to \$95 per person.

#### Vouchers...

- An approval letter will serve as a pre-paid voucher for applicants applying before the TEEX pre-registration deadline of July 6, 2015. TEEX requires that vouchers be submitted with the registration form(s).
- Requests received after the TEEX pre-registration deadline will not receive a voucher, however eligible fire departments may still apply through our normal reimbursement process.

#### Dorm Lodging & Meal Cards...

- TFS utilizes federal funds to offer dorm lodging & meal card grants. In order to be considered for federal funds, applicants must meet all of the following federal requirements.
  - 1) Serve a population of less than ten thousand.
  - 2) Submit a DUNS number
  - 3) Adopt NIMS with the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM).

Upon award, grant recipients will receive an A-133 Certification Letter that must be completed and returned for final grant approval.

- Please indicate on your application, the number of trainees in need of dorm lodging and/or meal cards.
- Federal funds are limited; only apply if you intend to utilize dorm lodging and/or meal cards.
- Reimbursement is not available for off campus commercial lodging and/ or off campus meals.

#### To apply, please submit:

✓ <u>Application for Fire Department Assistance – Volunteer Programs</u> (Form TFS-FO-400)

- Courses must be listed on the application and revised if registration changes are made.
- Applications must be received prior to the course start date.
- ✓ <u>Request for Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification</u> (Form W-9)

- ✓ <u>Revision Request Form Rural VFD Assistance Program</u> (Form TFS-FO-410)
  - (e.g. report a DUNS number, update the number of trainees, change courses, etc.)
